

## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

### AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WA, AND THE UNIVERSITY PLACE PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT GOVERNING THE CURRAN APPLE ORCHARD PARK TRUST FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of University Place, WA and the University Place Parks and Recreation District desire and are authorized per RCW 3934 to enter into an interlocal agreement regarding the Curran Apple Orchard Park Trust Fund;

WHEREAS, the City has accepted and deposited community gifts and donations into the Curran Apple Orchard Park Trust Fund;

WHEREAS, the District has an operations agreement with Pierce County as the contract purchaser; and

WHEREAS, there is no established process for joint City-District activities or capital improvements at the Curran Apple Orchard Park nor for the use of community Curran Apple Orchard Trust Funds; now therefore,

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED UPON BY THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE CITY COUNCIL AND THE BOARD OF THE UNIVERSITY PLACE PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT, THAT:

Section 1. Curran Apple Orchard Park Executive Committee. There shall be an Executive Committee of one City Councilmember appointed by the City Council, one District Park Board Member, appointed by the Park Board, and the City Treasurer or other City Manager designee who shall serve as an ex-officio non-voting member of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall be responsible for joint activities or improvements at the Park as authorized by the Park Board and City Council.


Section 2. Joint Activities, Maintenance or Capital Improvement Projects. Any joint activities or improvements shall be authorized by the City Council and the Board. Any such activities or improvements shall be provided per Conservation Futures requirements and guidelines. This agreement relates only to the use of Curran Apple Orchard Park Trust Fund. Nothing in the Agreement shall, in any way, conflict with the Park Board's primary use and responsibility regarding the Curran Apple Orchard Park.

Section 3. City Treasurer. The City shall act as the Treasurer for the Curran Apple Orchard Trust Fund, and as Treasurer shall receive funds into the Trust Fund and expend such funds for activities, maintenance and capital improvements at the Curran Apple Orchard Park as authorized by the Park Board and City Council through the Executive Committee.
