

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR MITIGATION PLANNING**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the City of University Place ("City"), a municipal corporation, and Pierce County Fire District 3 ("District"), a political subdivision of the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, pursuant to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, requires local governments to have approved natural hazard mitigation plans as a condition of future mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation plans are important for continued eligibility for federal predisaster and post disaster mitigation funds; and

WHEREAS, by separate agreement, Pierce County is to provide planning services for the City and the District, resulting in a natural hazard mitigation plan by November 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation planning will benefit both the City and the District; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District wish to share the costs of developing a joint hazard mitigation plan

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Cost Sharing. The total estimated cost for preparation of a hazard mitigation plan is Eighteen Thousand Dollars, (\$18,000). The City agrees to pay two-thirds of the cost of the plan (\$12,000) and the District agrees to pay one-third of the cost of the plan (\$6,000). If the cost of the plan is less than \$18,000, the parties agree to share any cost savings proportionally, two-thirds to the City and one-third to the District. If the cost of the plan exceeds \$18,000, the parties agree to share the additional costs proportionally, two-thirds from the City and one-third from the District. The parties acknowledge that any costs exceeding a total of \$21,000 will require approval of the respective governing bodies.

2. Payment. The City will be responsible for payment of all invoices received from Pierce County for preparation of the plan. Costs are expected to be billed quarterly, based upon a rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30) per hour. The District will reimburse the City quarterly based upon the hours billed for the quarter at a rate of Ten Dollars (\$10) per hour. Payments shall be made within 30 days of date of invoice from the City.

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation planning will benefit both the City and the District; and




The District enter into an agreement with the City of University Place to share cost for preparation of a joint hazard mitigation plan.




