City to host two open houses on Alameda gap project

At the request of the University Place Police and Fire departments, the City of University Place is evaluating the pros and cons of connecting two dead-end sections of Alameda Avenue West. The gap between the two road ends is about 20 feet long near 52nd Street West. Making the connection would allow police and fire vehicles to respond faster to emergencies in the southeast part of the city.

Traffic calming devices will be considered for the new section of road to help drivers obey the speed limit. The city will be taking citizen input on the final design of the project at two open houses to be held at City Hall, 3715 Bridgeport Way W. The first open house is Wednesday, September 21 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., and the second is Thursday, September 22 from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. Following the open houses, a date will be set for a public hearing in front of the City Council.
