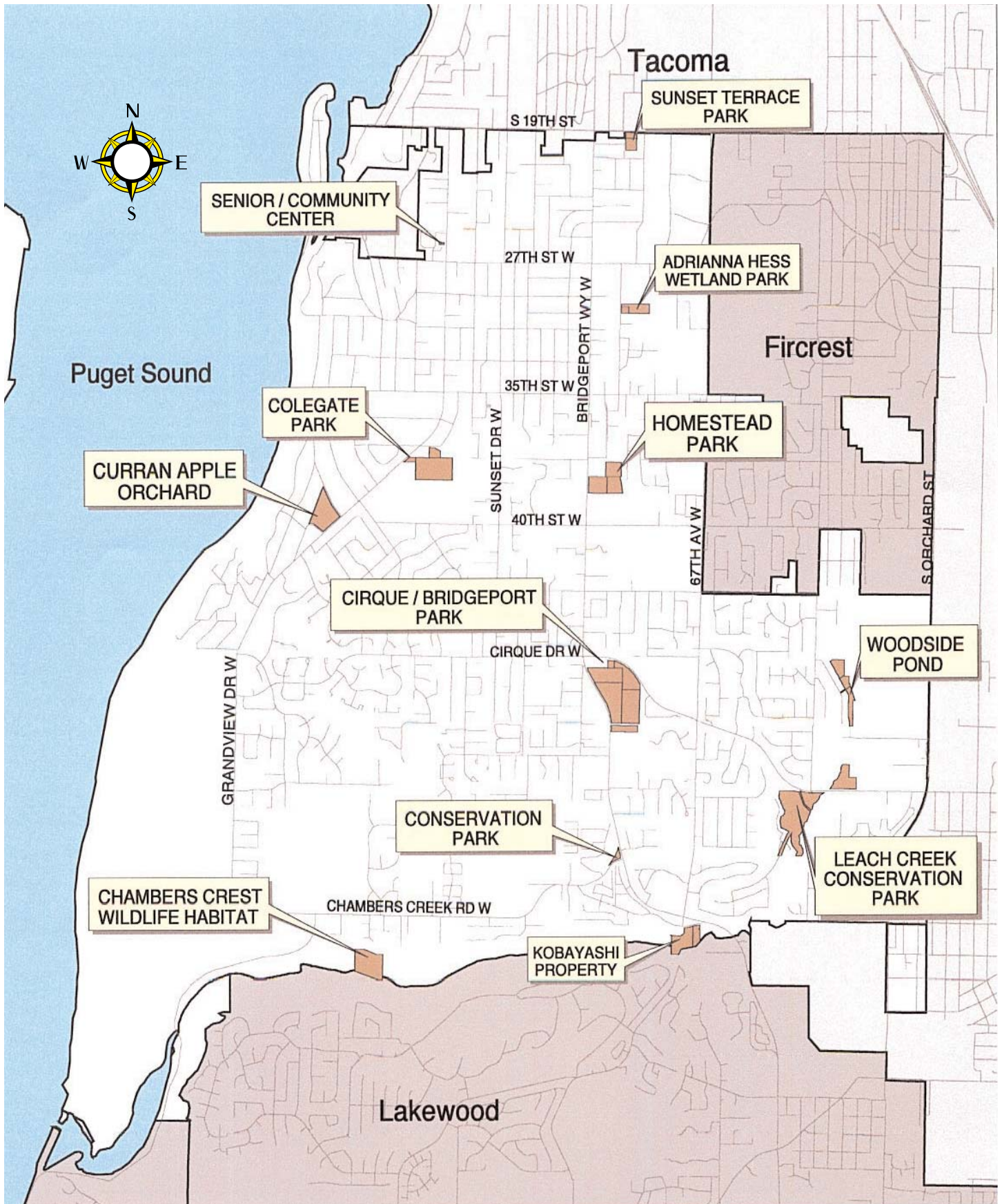


University Place Parks



Where are our Parks?

ADRIANNA HESS WETLAND PARK - 2917 Morrison Rd West

2-acre wetland park site south of 27th St. This wildlife habitat park contains trails, benches, and a deck overlooking the pond. The Tahoma Audubon Society office is located at the site. The non-profit group partners with the City to manage the park.



CHAMBERS CREST WILDLIFE HABITAT -

7.5 acre undeveloped wooded slope bordered by Chambers Creek. Currently has no public access, but sits next to a County park site.



CIRQUE/BRIDGPORT PARK - Corner of Cirque & Bridgeport Way West

27-acre undeveloped site centrally located in University Place with a view of Mt. Rainier. Future amenities to include ball fields, open space, trails skatepark, picnic area and possible community center. First phase of site development to begin in 2002.

COLEGATE PARK - 3717 Grandview Drive West

11-acre park located adjacent to Curtis Junior High School. Site contains six tennis courts, soft-ball/soccer field and school district administrative offices. A children's playground near Grandview was installed in 2001.

CONSERVATION PARK - Corner of Bridgeport Way West & Chambers Creek Rd
1.5-acre natural area at the NW corner of Bridgeport Way and Chambers Creek Lane.

CURRAN APPLE ORCHARD PARK - 3920 Grandview Dr West

7.33-acre park located off of Granview Drive, is open to the public. A volunteer group maintains the 200-apple tree orchard. This orchard offers opportunity for numerous educational programs and is the site for popular summer outdoor concerts and the annual Cider Squeeze event.



HOMESTEAD PARK - 3761 Bridgeport Way West

5.5 acres around City Hall and the new Public Safety building. This park extending east from Bridgeport Way, includes natural wooded areas, walking trails, fern grotto and a rhododendron garden. Amenities for public gatherings, picnics, and children's play will be added over time.

LEACH CREEK -

Wetland areas and trail easements, many dedicated to the City with new development. The goal is to create a natural linear park extending from the city limits at the south end to the City of Fircrest at the north.

SENIOR/COMMUNITY CENTER - 2534 Grandview Drive West

2,800 square foot building located at 2534 Grandview Drive, just north of 27th Street. The center is available for meetings, receptions and social gatherings. Amenities include fully equipped kitchen, tables and chairs. Please call 564-1992.



SUNSET TERRACE PARK - 1901 Seaview St West

2.25-acre ball field and children's playground on SE corner of 19th and Seaview.



WOODSIDE POND -

3.59-acres with Leach Creek and Woodside Creek flowing through the park on the east side. Site contains a stairway leading into the park, nature trails and an observation deck on the south end of the pond.

KOBYASHI PROPERTY - 6420 Chambers Creek Rd

5.5 acres of natural beauty on the confluence of Leach Creek and Chambers Creek. A unique site that accesses the Chambers Creek corridor from University Place. Site includes wetlands as well as old growth timber and majestic views of both creeks. *This property is currently occupied by a resident and is not open to the public at this time.*
