

WHERE ARE OUR PARKS?



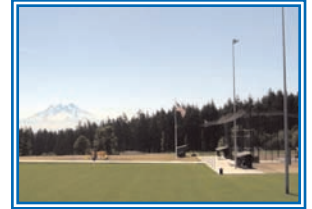
ADRIANA HESS WETLAND PARK -2917 Morrison Rd.

2 acre wetland park site south of 27th St. This wildlife habitat park contains trails, benches, and a deck overlooking the pond. The Tahoma Audubon Society office is located at the site. The non-profit group partners with the City to manage the park.

CHAMBERS CREST WILDLIFE HABITAT – 7.5 acre undeveloped wooded slope bordered by Chambers Creek. Currently has no public access, but lies next to the Chambers Creek Corridor.

CIRQUE/BRIDGEPORT PARK – 7250 CIRQUE DRIVE W

27-acre site currently being developed and centrally located in University Place with a view of Mt. Rainier. Amenities include ballfields, a soccer field, open space, trails, a skatepark, informal picnic area, tot lot and future community center.



COLEGATE PARK - 3717 Grandview Drive West



11-acre park located adjacent to Curtis Junior and Senior High School. Site contains a children's play area near Grandview, six tennis courts, soft ball/soccer field and school district administrative offices.

CONSERVATION PARK - Corner of Bridgeport Way and Chambers Creek Lane. 1.5-acre natural area features "Environmental Columns" art exhibit sponsored by U.P. for Art and local school students.

CURRAN APPLE ORCHARD - 3920 Grandview Drive W

7.33 – acre park is open to the public. A volunteer group maintains and operates the 200-apple tree orchard providing opportunities for numerous educational programs as well as the Summer Concert series and the annual Cider Squeeze. A Band Shell was completed in summer of 2005.



DRUM ROAD - Bridgeport Way W and Drum Road

This .33 landscaped pocket park features a half basketball court, a paved walkway and benches.



HOMESTEAD PARK - 3761 Bridgeport Way W

5.5 acres around City Hall and the Public Safety Building. This park extending east from Bridgeport Way, includes natural wooded areas, walking trails, fern grotto and a rhododendron collection. Amenities for public gatherings, picnics and children's play will be added over time.



KOBAYASHI PRESERVE – 6420 Chambers Creek Rd

5.5 acres of natural beauty on the confluence of Leach creek and Chambers Creek. This unique site accesses the Chambers Creek corridor from University Place. The site includes wetlands as well as old growth timber and majestic views of both creeks.

LEACH CREEK - Wetland areas and trail easements, many dedicated to the City with new development. The goal is to create a natural linear open space park and trail system extending from the city limits at the south end to the City of Fircrest at the north.

SENIOR/COMMUNITY CENTER - 2534 Grandview Dr W

2,800 square foot building located on Grandview Drive. The center is host to Friday Senior Meal site, and a weekly Bridge and Pinochle tournament and is available for meetings, receptions and social gatherings. Amenities include full commercial kitchen, tables and chairs and a recently completed patio (behind the center). For rental information please call (253) 564-1992.



SUNSET TERRACE PARK – 1902 Seaview St W- 2.25-acre ball field and children's playground on the SE corner of 19th and Seaview.

WOODSIDE POND NATURE PARK - Two parcels totaling 3.59 acres with Leach Creek and Woodside Creek flowing through the park on the east side. Site is not accessible to the public at this time.
