## **ORDINANCE NO. 567**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, TEMPORARILY REDUCING THE MAXIMUM SPEED ON CHAMBERS CREEK ROAD BETWEEN WOODLAKE DRIVE WEST AND 83<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE WEST FROM 30 MPH TO 25 MPH

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted PCC Chapter 10.40 by reference and established maximum speed limit on City Streets; and

WHEREAS, Pierce County will be performing rehabilitation work to the sewer tunnel along Chambers Creek Road that will result in heavy construction in the center of the street between Woodlake Drive West and 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue West; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that, in the interest of public safety, the speed limit on Chambers Creek Road between Woodlake Drive West and 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue West should be reduced from 30 mph to 25 mph for the duration of said construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Setting Maximum Speed Limit.</u> The maximum speed limit on Chambers Creek Road between Woodlake Drive West and 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue West is set at 25 miles per hour.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date and Publication.</u> A summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This Ordinance shall be in effect five days after publication.

Section 3. <u>Sunset Date.</u> This Ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the in-street construction by Pierce County of the Chambers Creek Interceptor Tunnel Rehabilitation Project Phase 2. At the completion of the in street work for said project, this Ordinance will automatically expire.
