#### **ORDINANCE NO. 535**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNVIERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE TRAFFIC IMPACT FEE SCHEDULE, PROJECT LIST AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of University Place adopted a Comprehensive Plan establishing the intent of the citizens to ensure that new developments pay a proportionate share of the cost of new facilities needed to serve such growth; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan contains a complete description of the existing level of service for transportation facilities and the impacts of future growth on that level of service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 494 to establish the City's traffic impact fee program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance Nos. 499, 503, and 520 all of which revised the traffic impact fee program; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 520 specifically states that the Traffic Impact Fee Schedule adopted in Ordinance 520 shall be reviewed by the City Council annually in conjunction with the update of the Traffic Impact Fee System Improvement List; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend the Traffic Impact Fee Project List and the Traffic Impact Fee Schedule to reflect the current review and analysis; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the Traffic Impact Fee Project List and the Traffic Impact Fee Schedule resulted in a revised traffic impact fee.

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Authority. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Washington State Growth Management Act codified at chapter 36.70A RCW and at RCW 82.02.050 to 82.02.100.
- Section 2. <u>Traffic Impact Fee Project List</u>. The Traffic Impact Fee Project List shall be supplemented with the calculations attached hereto as Exhibit A. These calculations are hereby incorporated into this ordinance by reference as if set forth in full.
- Section 3. <u>Traffic Impact Fee Study</u>. The Traffic Impact Fee Study is amended as attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated into this ordinance by this reference as if set forth in full.
- **Section 4.** Traffic Impact Fee Schedule. The Traffic Impact Fee Schedule that sets forth the amount of the traffic impact fee on a per Peak-Hour Trip basis is revised as attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated into this ordinance by this reference as if set in full.
- **Section 5. Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.
- **Section 6.** <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.

#### **EXHIBIT C**

### **Traffic Impact Fee Schedule**

Adopted November 10, 2008

The traffic impact fee shall be assessed against all new development requiring a Permit on a per Peak-Hour Trip basis and calculated using this schedule, which identifies the adopted fee amount per Peak Hour Trip generated. The Traffic Impact Fee Schedule represents the City's determination of the appropriate share of System Improvement costs to be paid by new growth and development.
