ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1999-2000 STAFFING PLAN ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 211 ADOPTING THE 1999-2000 BIENNIAL BUDGET BY ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL SENIOR PROJECT ENGINEER POSITION AND A RECREATION COORDINATOR POSITION

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1998, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 211 adopting the 1999-2000 Biennial Budget, Salary Schedule, and Benefits Plan, Authorizing Positions, and Appropriating Funds:

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Senior Project Engineer and the Recreation Coordinator salary ranges in the 1999-2000 Biennial Budget;

WHEREAS, the workload and expertise needed for an additional Senior Project Engineer exists for the foreseeable future;

WHEREAS, with the departure of the Parks & Recreation Manager, it is necessary to reallocate the responsibilities to respond to the work plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>1999-2000 Staffing Plan Amended.</u> The 1999-2000 Staffing Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 211 with the 1999-2000 biennial budget, is hereby amended to establish an additional Senior Project Engineer position and a Recreation Coordinator position:

Section 2. <u>Publication and Effective Date</u>. A summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after its publication.
