ORDINANCE NO. 240

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 13.20.040, OF THE UNIVERSITY PLACE MUNICIPAL CODE, TO REQUIRE A CITY INSPECTION OF AND ACCEPTANCE OF STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM WORK BEFORE BACKFILL IS PLACED OVER STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, on May 4, 1997, the City Council adopted the City of University Place Public Works Standards; and

WHEREAS, since adoption of the Public Works Standards, several necessary changes have become apparent; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 1998, the City Council met to discuss the issue further; and,

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1999, the City Council held a second public hearing to hear and duly consider testimony.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amending Section 13.20.040. <u>Section 13.20.040 is amended by adding a new subsection (V) as follows:</u>

Section 13.20.040(U) Construction, of Chapter 13.20, Storm Drainage, of Title 19 of the University Place Municipal Code, is Amended to read as follows:

- (V). <u>Inspection of the storm drainage system must be called for and the work accepted by the City before</u> any backfill is placed over storm drainage facilities.
- Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.
- **Section 3.** Publication and Effective Date. A summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect five days after publication.
