ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to establish fees and charges for services provided; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to recover the cost of services where fees may be appropriate; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Fees Established</u>. In addition to any fees established in other City ordinances, the City may establish or amend fees by resolution for services provided by the City.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be effective on the official date of incorporation.
