## RESOLUTION NO. 98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE ADOPT-A-STREET LITTER CONTROL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, RCW 47.40 permits local governments to implement Adopt-A-Highway Programs for local roads, to enable volunteers to supplement City litter control efforts by adopting portions of City streets and picking up litter along these portions of streets; and

WHEREAS, there are volunteer organizations within the City of University Place that are willing to demonstrate their commitment to a clean environment by giving their time and energy to keep sections of City streets litter free; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Place desires to encourage the efforts of the volunteer organizations by the creation and implementation of the "City of University Place Adopt-A-Street Litter Control Program" which will allow volunteer organizations to adopt a section of City street and to pick up litter along that section; and

WHEREAS, both the public and the City of University Place will benefit from such a program in that it will establish a partnership between citizen volunteers and the City to reduce roadside litter and build civic pride in a litter free City; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

The City of University Place certifies that the University Place Adopt-A-Street Program meets all requisites required by State statute, and further, that the Public Works Department intends to implement and administer this Program to ensure safety of all participants in conjunction with beautification of University Place.
