

RESOLUTION NO. 112

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THE PIERCE COUNTY TRANSIT BOARD AMEND ITS BYLAWS TO CREATE TWO NEW BOARD SEATS FOR MEMBERS FROM THE CITIES OF UNIVERSITY PLACE AND LAKEWOOD.

WHEREAS, public transportation plays an important role in making jobs, shopping, medical care and other services more accessible to all citizens;

WHEREAS, the Cities of Lakewood and University Place are the second and third largest cities in Pierce County and are concerned about the mobility of their citizens, but are not represented on the Pierce Transit Board; and,


WHEREAS, Lakewood and University Place represent major urban centers in Pierce County and consultation with the two cities is essential to sound regional transportation planning; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Transit Board Bylaw Amendment. The University Place City Council requests that the Pierce Transit Board hold a special meeting to consider amendment of its bylaws to create two additional board seats. One seat would be for a member selected by the Lakewood City Council. The other seat would be for a member selected by the University Place City Council.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon signing.
