WHEREAS, as provided in the Rules of Procedure, the City Council is required to consider the procedures in the month of January of every even-numbered year, and may review the rules at any other time it chooses; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. <u>Section 7.A., Meetings, of the Council Rules of Procedure Amended.</u> Section 7.A., Meetings, of the City Council Rules of Procedure are amended as follows:
 - A. <u>Regular Meetings.</u> The Council shall hold Regular Meetings on the first and third Monday of each month. The Regular Meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m., <u>unless an Executive Session is scheduled at the beginning of the agenda; if so, the meeting shall begin at 6:30 p.m. <u>If an Executive Session is scheduled, it will be held before the Regular Meeting starting at 6:30 p.m.</u> Should any meeting occur on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held at the same hour and place on the following Tuesday.</u>
- Section 2. <u>Section 7.B., Study Sessions, of the Council Rules of Procedure</u>

 <u>Amended.</u> Section 7.B., Study Sessions, of the City Council Rules of Procedure are amended as follows:
 - 7.B. <u>Study Sessions</u>. The Council shall hold Study sessions on the second—and-fourth Monday of each month between 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Should any meeting date occur on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be canceled. Study Sessions will be informal meetings for the purpose of reviewing: The upcoming Regular Meeting preliminary agenda; forthcoming programs and future Council agenda items; progress on current programs or projects; or other information the City Manager feels is appropriate. Final action will not be taken on Study Session agenda items.
- Section 3. <u>Section 8.A., Order of Business for Regular Meetings, of the Council Rules of Procedure Amended.</u> Section 8.A., Order of Business for Regular Meetings of the Council Rules of Procedure are amended as follows:

- 10. Public Hearing
- 11. Ordinances, Resolutions and Motions
- 12. Council Considerations
- 13. Report of City Manager
- 14. Report of Mayor
- 15. Public Comments
- 16. Executive Session (as necessary)
- 17.16. Adjournment.

*If an Executive Session is scheduled at the beginning of the agenda, the meeting it-will begin at 6:30 p.m.
