RESOLUTION NO. 167

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY (DOE) FOR COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT PROJECT ASSISTANCE UNDER THE FEDERAL COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 1972, AS AMENDED THROUGH 1996, FOR THE PREPARATION OF A NEW SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1995 the City of University Place passed Ordinance No. 60 adopting new interim shoreline use regulations;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 60 found that the City of University Place intends to adopt a shoreline master program, including use regulations, in full compliance with Chapter 90.58 RCW and WAC Title 173 but that there was insufficient time to adopt the program in accordance with all governing procedures and to obtain approval of the Department of Ecology before the date of incorporation;

WHEREAS, the proper regulation of the shorelines is necessary to enable the residents of University Place to plan for and to achieve the type of community they desire;

WHEREAS, Coastal Zone Management project assistance planning grants administered by DOE may fund up to 50 percent of the project cost for the preparation of a new shoreline master program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS,

Section 1. <u>Application Submittal Authorized</u>. Submittal of a formal application by the City Manager or his/her designee to the Washington State Department of Ecology for Coastal Zone Management project assistance to partially finance the preparation of a new City of University Place Shoreline Master Program is hereby authorized.

Section 2. <u>Funding Assistance Received</u>. Any funding assistance received shall be used for the preparation of a new shoreline master program.

Section 3. <u>City's Share.</u> The City of University Place anticipates its share of the project funding to be derived from in-kind donations and general government revenue.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon signing.
