RESOLUTION NO. 397

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, WAIVING FIREWORKS PERMIT FEES FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council has been approached on several occasions by non-profit organizations that operate fireworks stands to earn charitable funds to be utilized for social services and educational grants and purposes within the City of University Place; and

WHEREAS, it is cumbersome and consumes significant staff and volunteer time to repeatedly ask Council for a fireworks stand fee waiver for non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in best interest of the community to waive fireworks permit fees when funds obtained from the sales of fireworks will be used within the community for social and educational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Amend Fee Schedule adopted by Resolution No. 328</u>. Resolution No. 328 is hereby amended as follows:

FIREWORKS FEES

A. Fees for temporary fireworks stand permit	\$100.00 <u>/stand</u>
B. Fees for temporary fireworks stand permit	
operated by non-profit organizations	<u> </u>
C. Fees for a public display permit	\$245.00

A liability policy(s) is required in accordance with the Fireworks Ordinance and as follows for both firework stands and public displays.

- A. \$500,000 for injuries to any one person in one accident or occurrence.
- B. \$1,000,000 for injuries to two or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.
- C. \$500,000 for damage to property in any once accident or occurrence.
- D. \$1,000,000 combines single limit for any one accident or occurrence.

A Bond for Clean up is required in accordance with the Fireworks Ordinance in the amount of \$500.00 in a bond or cashiers check for all fireworks stands.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and be retroactive to June 30, 2003.
