WHEREAS, a hazard mitigation plan is necessary to be eligible for federal mitigation grant funding, and,

WHEREAS, the required 25% match could be funded by a mix of in-kind staff hours and funding from \$12,000.00 the City of University Place has already appropriated in the 2004 budget for hazard mitigation planning and,

WHEREAS, funding received as a result of the grant application could be used to contract with Pierce County to develop a hazard mitigation plan.
