A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON IN SUPPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY PLACE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 83 PROPOSITION NO. 3, A TECHNOLOGY CAPITAL PROJECTS LEVY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Support of University Place School District Proposition No. 3.</u> This Resolution constitutes support of the University Place School District Proposition No. 3 on the February 7, 2006 ballot. This Proposition authorizes acquiring technology and equipment, including classroom computers and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District.
