RESOLUTION NO. 600

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION 588, ESTABLISHING THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the need to amend the Park & Recreation Commission membership to include the addition of a temporary alternate-youth position, increasing membership from seven to eight members;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON. AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Amending Parks & Recreation Commission Membership, Section 4 of Resolution No. 588</u>, establishing the Parks & Recreation Commission, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. <u>Membership</u> There shall be seven members of the Parks & Recreation Commission. Members shall be city residents, except the City Council may appoint one member who may reside outside the city. Members will immediately forfeit their appointment if they move outside the city limits. Members of the Parks & Recreation Commission shall serve without compensation. In addition, it is desirable, but not mandatory, that Commission members be drawn from throughout the city. It is desirable, but not mandatory, that the Commissioners reflect the diversity and geographic distribution of the citizenry of University Place, as well as the recreational, sports, conservation and cultural interests to the extent possible. It is also desirable that at least one member should come from the senior community and one from the youth population, if possible. A temporary alternate-youth position for the Park and Recreation Commission is being added and will expire when the current youth position is vacated. At that time, membership will revert to the seven members.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date.</u> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
