A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A PROPERTY ACQUISITION GRANT TO THE PIERCE COUNTY CONSERVATION FUTURES (PCCF)OFFICE AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15 RCW, ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS, FOR THE CHAMBERS-LEACH CREEK TRAIL AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION AREA

WHEREAS, our organization has approved a comprehensive plan that includes this project area;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Pierce County Conservation Futures, county funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of land acquisition and/or facility development; and

WHEREAS, our organization considers it in the best public interest to complete the land acquisition and/or facility development project described in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council be authorized to make formal application to Pierce County Conservation Futures Office for funding assistance;
- 2. Any fund assistance received be used for implementation of the project referenced above;
- 3. Our organization hereby certifies that its share of project funding (\$65,000.00); is committed and will de derived from the City's Park Land Acquisition Fund;
- 4. We acknowledge that any property acquired or facility developed with financial aid from Pierce County Conservation Futures must be placed in use for the funded purpose and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by our organization and PCCF;
- 5. This resolution becomes part of a formal application to Pierce County Conservation Futures Office.
