A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICIAL TIME, PLACE, AND LOCATION OF CITY COUNCIL REGULAR AND COMMITTEE MEETINGS, AND PROVIDING THAT ACTIONS OF THE CITY COUNCIL SHALL OCCUR AT MEETINGS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 52

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of University Place adopted Resolution No. 12 on June 7, 1995, to establish a regular meeting date, time, and location for its meetings, pursuant to RCW 35A.12.110; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 25 on June 21, 1995, amending Resolution No. 12 to change the location of all City Council meetings to the Town Hall Meeting Room; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 52, amending Resolution Nos. 12 and 25 to change its meeting schedule to two regular business meetings each month, and two study sessions each month; and

WHEREAS, at its Special Council meeting of January 19, 2010, the City Council has determined that it will move to a schedule of two regular business meetings each month commencing at 6:30 p.m., and one special/study session each month commencing at 6:30 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Regular Meeting Dates.</u> Section 1 of Resolution No. 52 is amended to read as follows:

Regular Meetings. The City Council shall hold its regular meetings on the first and third Monday of each month commencing at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall Meeting Room, Windmill Village, 3715 Bridgeport Way West, University Place, Washington, or at such other times and locations as may be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. <u>Special Meeting/Study Session.</u> Section 2 of Resolution No. 52 is amended to read as follows:

<u>Special Meeting/Study Session.</u> The City Council shall hold special meeting/study sessions commencing at 6:30 p.m. on the second Monday of each month at the Town Hall Meeting Room, Windmill Village, 3715 Bridgeport Way West, University Place, Washington, or at such other time and location as may be determined and noticed pursuant to statute.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
