- ^{E2} All contractors must have a valid City of University Place business license prior to doing work in the City. Contact the Business Licensing Office at 253.566.5656.

- ^G Health Department Approval of Septic System is required **at time of permit submittal**. Contact the TPCHD at 253.798.6470.
