RESOLUTION NO. 723

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DIRECTING THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION TO EXAMINE THE CITY'S CURRENT AND FUTURE PARKS AND RECREATION NEEDS INCLUDING OPTIONS FOR FUNDING THOSE NEEDS FOR PURPOSES OF EVALUATING THE CITY'S LONG-TERM PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE LEVELS AND FUNDING OPTIONS OVER THE NEXT TWENTY YEARS

WHEREAS, the City Council's 2013-2014 goals identified "long range Parks, Recreation and Senior Center needs" as one of its primary goals; and

WHEREAS, through anticipated future growth and development, the City's density is expected to increase; and

WHEREAS, future growth is expected to increase demand for Parks, Recreation and Senior Center services; and

WHEREAS, the City's long-range financial forecast anticipates declining revenues available for City services, including parks, recreation and senior center services in 2016; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to develop a funding strategy for meeting those needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

The Parks and Recreation Commission is directed to examine the City's current and future Parks, Recreation and Senior Center needs including options for funding those needs for purposes of evaluating the City's long-term Parks and Recreation service levels and options for funding those needs over the next twenty years. The Commission will report progress and status of their study on a regular basis and submit a final report for Council consideration by the fourth quarter of 2014.
