The Site Development Review Checklist was developed to assist applicants in completing the application package and to reduce permit review times.

### **Instructions for completing the Site Development Review Checklist:**

- 1. The checklist shall be filled out completely and turned in with the site development permit application. Any application that does not include a completed checklist will not be accepted.
- 2. The applicant shall provide a response for each checklist item. If the applicant's response is "yes", the submittal documents must be in complete agreement with the printed statement. If the applicant's response is "no", the response must be accompanied by a written explanation. Additional sheets may be attached.
- 3. The City will review the checklist for accuracy. The checklist will be returned to the applicant with City comments if any deficiencies are noted in the accuracy review. Further review of the submittal documents will be suspended until the checklist has been resubmitted with all deficiencies corrected.

## **General Requirements**

### **PLAN FORMAT**

- a. Plan sheet size shall be 24"x 36"
- b. A title block shall be provided on each plan sheet. The title block shall list at a minimum the development title, the name, address, and phone number of the firm or individual preparing the plan, the initials of the person who designed the plans, drew the plans, and checked the plans, a revision block, date, page (of pages) numbering, and sheet title.
- c. All plan sheets and reports shall contain the signed and dated Engineer's stamp.
- d. All plan sheets shall include the standard City approval block.
