RESOLUTION NO. 971

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PIERCE COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSES OF COMPREHENSIVE SOLID AND HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANNING WITHIN THE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 of the RCW, RCW 70A.205.040, RCW, 70A.205.075, and RCW 70A.300.350 establishes the obligations, conditions, and measures for comprehensive solid and hazardous waste management planning; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Place and the County acknowledge that the County intends to enter into identical individual agreements with the cities and towns of Bonney Lake, Buckley, Carbonado, DuPont, Eatonville, Edgewood, Fife, Fircrest, Gig Harbor, Lakewood, Milton, Orting, Puyallup, Roy, Ruston, South Prairie, Steilacoom, Sumner, University Place, and Wilkeson, creating a single agreement among all parties who execute identical individual agreements to prepare a coordinated, comprehensive solid & hazardous waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, RCW 70A.205.040 requires cities to either 1) prepare their own solid waste management plans for integration into the county plan or 2) agree with the county to participate in a joint city-county solid waste management plan or 3) authorize the county to prepare a city plan for inclusion in the comprehensive county solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the County and many of the signatory cities previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the purpose of implementing the 2000 Tacoma-Pierce County Solid Waste Management Plan, which now needs to be reviewed, updated and replaced;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Authorization</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with the County for the purposes of comprehensive solid and hazardous waste management planning within the County.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
