## **RESOLUTION NO. 978**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE CITY COUNCIL'S COLLECTIVE GOALS FOR THE 2023-2024 BIENNIUM

WHEREAS, the University Place City Council have worked diligently to establish their collective City Council goals for the City's 2023–2024 biennium; and

WHEREAS, during the 2023–2024, the City Council in its sole discretion may add, remove or revise the matters included in these goals by further resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to formally adopt the 2023–2024 City Council goals to inform residents, guide the budgeting process and provide policy guidance to the City Manager;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, THAT THE 2023–2024 CITY COUNCIL GOALS ARE HEREBY ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Public Safety: Increase public safety and funding for public safety.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. Develop financial strategy for public safety including public levy
- 2. <u>Economic Development</u>: Utilize targeted strategies with focused efforts to grow and strengthen the business community.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. District sub-area plans
    - ii. Business start-up cost study
    - iii. Business sector analysis
    - iv. Wayfinding signs and electronic messaging board
- 3. <u>Infrastructure</u>: Overview of infrastructure to plan for future needs.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. Parks maintenance and growth
    - ii. Street maintenance and growth
    - iii. Sewers
- 4. Engagement: Increased community engagement.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. Foundational marketing and education
    - ii. Increased community outreach and partnerships (i.e., school district, community groups, etc.)
    - iii. Review analytics, measurements and provide community surveys
    - iv. Evaluate best practices
- 5. <u>Recreation</u>: Review opportunities for developing some level of recreation services to the community.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. Park public usage
    - ii. Field rentals

- iii. Regional providers
- iv. Explore developing interlocal(s) and partnership with school district and neighboring cities
- 6. Regional Influence: Find ways to broaden the City's influence regionally.
  - a. Areas of focus:
    - i. Participation in professional and organizational associations by Councilmembers and staff
    - ii. Participation in commissions, boards, taskforces and public and private associations by Councilmembers and staff
    - iii. Development of financial strategies to leverage regional, State, and federal funding and/or policies for City needs
