#### **ORDINANCE NO. 767**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE. WASHINGTON. RELATING TO BUDGETS AND FINANCE, ADOPTING THE 2023-2024 BIENNIAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the tax estimates and budget for the City of University Place, Washington, for the 2023/2024 fiscal biennium have been prepared and filed as provided by the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the budget was printed for distribution and notice published in the official paper of the City of University Place setting the time and place for hearings on the budget and said notice stating that all taxpayers calling at the Office of the City Clerk would be furnished a copy of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 Proposed Biennial Budget was submitted to the City Council and City Clerk on September 23, 2022; and study sessions on the 2023-2024 Biennial Budget were held on October 3, October 17, and November 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, public hearings on the 2023/2024 Biennial Budget were held on October 17, November 7, and November 21, 2022;

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, **WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. 2023-2024 Biennial Budget Adoption. The budget for the City of University Place, Washington, for the 2023-2024 biennium is hereby adopted in the amounts and for the purposes as shown on the attached Exhibits A-1 and A-2 (2023 and 2024 Adopted Budgets) and Exhibit B (2023-2024 Salary Ranges).

- Section 2. Administration. The City Manager shall administer the Biennial Budget approved herein.
- Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are declared separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this ordinance or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.
- Section 4. Ratification. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and affirmed.
- Section 5. Publication and Effective Date. A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2023.
