Section 1. <u>Adoption of the 2023 Annual Preliminary Park Advisory Commission Work Plan.</u> The City Council directs the Park Advisory Commission to review and make recommendations regarding those items listed in the 2023 Preliminary Park Advisory Commission Work Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
