RESOLUTION NO. 1014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, MAKING APPOINTMENTS AS THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE ON THE PIERCE COUNTY OPIOID ABATEMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1013 on June 14, 2023, authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City, Pierce County, and the Cities of Auburn, Bonney Lake, Edgewood, Fife, Gig Harbor, Lakewood, Puyallup, Sumner and Tacoma ("Parties") for the creation of an Opioid Abatement Council (OAC) required by the One Washington MOU (to which the City is a party); and

WHEREAS, the City of University Place has entered into said Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement requires that, within 120 days of execution, each party must appoint a representative and an alternative representative to the OAC; and

WHEREAS, the City appoints Jennifer Hales as its representative to the OAC and Leslie Blaisdell as the alternate representative to the OAC; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of University Place considers that these appointments are in the best interests of the residents of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment. The appointment of Jennifer Hales and Leslie Blaisdell as the City of University Place representative and alternate representative, respectively, to the Pierce County Opioid Abatement Council is confirmed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
