## **RESOLUTION NO. 1028**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, RECEIVING A PETITION FOR VACATION AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF AN UNIMPROVED LAND ON  $29^{\rm TH}$  STREET WEST EXTENDING FROM CRYSTAL SPRINGS ROAD WEST TO SUNSET DRIVE WEST

WHEREAS, the City of University Place has received a petition signed by owners of at least twothirds (2/3) of the property abutting an unimproved land on 29<sup>th</sup> Street West extending from Crystal Springs Road West to Sunset Drive West, located within the City, requesting that the same be vacated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to State law, a hearing on such vacation shall be set by Resolution, with the date of such hearing being not more than sixty (60) days nor less than twenty (20) days after the date of passage of such Resolution; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Public Hearing Scheduled</u>. A public hearing is hereby scheduled on the vacation of a portion of the property abutting an unimproved land on 29<sup>th</sup> Street West extending from Crystal Springs Road West to Sunset Drive West, located within the City, legally described as shown on the document attached hereto marked as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter can be heard, on the sixteenth day of January, 2024, at the City of University Place Council Chambers, 3609 Market Place West, University Place, Washington, 98466 with all persons wishing to speak to the vacation at the public hearing being invited to attend.
- 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
