Section1. Adoption of the 2024 Annual Preliminary Planning Commission Work Plan. The City Council hereby directs the Planning Commission to review and make recommendations regarding those items listed in the 2024 Planning Commission Work Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
