After studying various other options, the City determined 90-minute parking meters are the most cost-efficient and effective way to ensure a fair and equitable turnover of parking spots for those patronizing businesses in the Village, especially customers with accessibility and mobility issues.

The City's Public Works crews are restriping parking stalls and installing posts for parking meters along the east and west sides of Market Place West
